At the beginning of the 20th century in England, the rules of women's basketball were modified to form an entirely new sport exclusively for women: netball. The rules were codified and spread throughout the British Empire. Today, netball is popular in Commonwealth countries and is played by 20 million players of all ages and in 80 countries.






